The following information serves as a brief guideline and includes some “at a glance” info on membership for prospective members.

For COMPLETE Rules and Regulations contact the Chuckanut

Beaches Association to confirm your address qualifies for

membership. Membership includes access to 5 private beaches. There is small craft/boat storage for members at some of the beaches, upon availability, for an additional fee. All membership fees go towards maintaining, cleaning and upgrading our beautiful beaches as well as operational costs of the Beaches Association.

Membership Fees & Beach Storage Fees

New Membership- \$500

Renewing member, Annual Fee- \$50

Lapsed membership, reinstatement Fee - \$100 (Within 1 year)

Kayak/SUP/Canoe Storage, Initial Fee- \$25 Annual renewal Fee- \$25

Dinghy/Rowboat Storage, Initial registration Fee- \$50 Annual renewal Fee- \$50

Beach 1 Gate Key Deposit- \$25 and signed Key Agreement (one time only)



Chuckanut Beaches Association General Rules and Good Neighbor Polices

1. CBA Beaches are open to members and their guests. All non-family guests must be accompanied to the beach by a current CBA member in good standing. **AIRBNB, VRBO, AND OTHER SHORT-TERM RENTERS ARE NOT ALLOWED AT CBA BEACHES UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY A MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING.** Long term renters of eligible members (more than 6 months) do not need to be accompanied by a member.
 2. All beach users shall identify themselves and their address if requested by any member.
 3. **PARKING IS LIMITED TO ONE CAR PER MEMBERSHIP. PLEASE CARPOOL, WALK, OR RIDE A BIKE.** Bikes racks are provided at some beaches. Park in designated areas only.
 4. **NO OVERNIGHT PARKING AT ANY OF THE CBA BEACH PARKING AREAS.**
 5. Quiet hours at all beaches is **8 PM to 8 AM.**
 6. **Respect our neighbors.** Members should know the boundary lines of our beaches and advise their guests to not wander onto neighboring properties.
 7. **ALL GAS OR ELECTRIC MOTOR-POWERED WATERCRAFT must observe a no wake/slow zone withing the mooring buoys when leaving and returning to shore.**
 8. For **gatherings of ten (10) or more**, please contact the Beach Steward.
 9. Respect our beaches and natural resources. **PACK IT IN & PACK IT OUT.**
 10. **NO SMOKING OR VAPING IS ALLOWED ON CBA BEACHES.**
 11. **NO FIREWORKS ALLOWED.**
 12. **NO FIRES ARE ALLOWED UNLESS APPROVED IN ADVANCE BY THE CURRENT CBA PRESIDENT.**
 13. All stored boats/crafts must have a current CBA permit.
 14. Pets are allowed, please control them especially when children are present. **ALWAYS PICK-UP AFTER YOUR PET!**
 15. Get to know your Beach Stewards.
 16. All crab pots and gear must be removed from beach at the end of crabbing season.
 17. **It is the responsibility of each member to read and follow the CBA Boat Rules and Regulations, and the CBA Regulations and Good Neighbor policies. It is also the responsibility of each member to inform their family members and guests of the above regulations.**

Small Craft Storage guidelines

1. Chuckanut Beaches Association is not responsible for damage incurred to, or caused by, stored boats/crafts, nor is it responsible for authorized or unauthorized use of boats/crafts, paddles or crab pots.
2. Only non-motorized boats/crafts of currently paid in full members may be stored on the racks.
3. A numbered storage space will be provided to the member by the association. There is a **two (2) boat/craft limit per household membership**, except for a designated family storage space. Storage shall be paid in full by a member in good standing and they must sign the BOAT/CRAFT STORAGE AGREEMENT.
4. Members must affix their **name, phone number and registration sticker** to the end of the boat/craft where it is visible.
5. Boats/crafts shall not be stored overnight on the intertidal zone of any of the beaches.
6. The storage of boat trailers and other private property (other than crab pots) is not allowed on the beaches. The storage of gasoline and other fuels is prohibited. The use of a hand operated dolly for human powered boats is limited to certain beaches. Dollies must be parked in a designated site, one dolly (1) per membership.
7. To register a stored boat/craft annually, a fee shall be submitted to the Chuckanut Beaches Association, along with the member's name, address, phone number, description of the boat/craft, and intended beach location. A boat/craft storage sticker, valid from January 1st to December 31st of the current year will then be issued and placed on the boat by the member near their affixed name.
8. Boats/crafts in non-compliance shall be removed after a reasonable effort is made to notify the owner.
